PRELUDE I

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform in ONE student recital
- Attend ONE Concert at ANMS *or elsewhere* and write a short review
- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel

PRELUDE II

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform in TWO student recitals
- Attend ONE Concert at ANMS *or elsewhere* and write a short review
- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel

PRELUDE III

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform in TWO student recitals
- Attend ONE Concert at ANMS *or elsewhere* and write a short review
- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel

BRONZE I & II

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform a solo in TWO student recitals and a duet with teacher or another student
- Attend TWO concerts at ANMS or

elsewhere, with a written review of each to be submitted to Jeanne in the Public Relations Office.

- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel

SILVER I, II & III

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform a solo on TWO student recitals
- Attend TWO concerts at ANMS or elsewhere with written review of each. Submit two written reviews to Jeanne in the Public Relations Office
- Write an original scholarly paper on a musical topic of at least one typewritten page in length
- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel

GOLD I & II

- Enroll in Private Lessons at ANMS
- Perform a solo on TWO student recitals
- Attend TWO concerts at ANMS or elsewhere, with a written review of each to be submitted to Jeanne in the Public Relations Office
- Write an original scholarly paper on a musical topic of at least TWO typewritten pages in length to be submitted to Jeanne Gugino, PR.
- Play scales and TWO memorized solos for a Faculty Panel
